

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DAYTON
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 11, 2015
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Diana Clabeaux, Thomas Chupa, Edward Lulas, Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk, Brian Taber, Highway Superintendent, Justin Dye, James Musacchio, Attorney, Absent: Ken Volk
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Lulas. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they plowed nineteen days, serviced the wood chipper, pushed back snow banks with the loader, and babied the 1996 truck its getting tired, the Board needs to keep an upgrade in mind.
- CLERK: Clerk Bennett reported that DCO Kathy Hagner picked up a lost dog on Gabel Street, had five delinquent dogs in January and 19 delinquent dogs in February.
- Clerk Bennett reminded the Board about the anniversary of the Town and asked how they wanted to be involved, Supervisor said to let them know what was needed to be done.
- Clerk Bennett reported to the Board that she had collected \$92,095.39 in taxes, \$920.95 in penalty and \$15.00 for a returned check for a total of \$93,031.34 for the month of February.
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard 15 Vehicle & Traffic, 1 Penal Law, 7 Town Law, 1 Small Claim, 2 ECL and collected \$1,704.00.
- ATTORNEY: Attorney James Musacchio reported that the agreement with Cattaraugus County Bank had been signed.
- SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith reported to the Board that Anne Merkt would like to continue to serve on the Gowanda Ambulance Board and Don Merkt would like to serve on the Board of Assessment Review. A motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to appoint Anne Merkt to the Gowanda Ambulance Board and Don Merkt to the Board of Assessment Review. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- Supervisor Smith also reported that the pickup trucks he found were over the authorized \$12,000, one was a gas engine for \$30,000 the other diesel for \$40,000.

- BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Clabeaux, seconded by Councilman Lulas to pay General Funds claims #44-65, in the amount of \$22,796.26, as set forth in Abstract #3, dated March 11,2015, Highway Fund claims #21-34, in the amount of \$8,947.44 as set forth in Abstract #3, dated

March 11, 2015. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.
