

REGULAR MEETING  
TOWN OF DAYTON  
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 8, 2015  
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Diana Clabeaux, Thomas Chupa, Ken Volk, Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk, Brian Taber, Highway Superintendent, Pat Volk, James Musacchio, Attorney, Absent: Edward Lulas
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Clabeaux, seconded by Councilman Chupa. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they plowed six days, moved snow to prevent flooding in some areas, took down a couple of trees on Rice Road and then trimmed the rest of the trees on the road. We put the grader in the shop to service so we can grade roads when it dries up, we have started sweeping roads and filling pot holes.
- Also reported that the Town received \$9,319.86 more in Winter Recovery funds and CHIPS will be \$62,998.61 .
- CLERK: Clerk Bennett reported that the Rabies Clinic will be at the DPW garage in Little Valley on May 2, 2015, 9 am to noon.
- Clerk Bennett explained that the Town has two parcels in the County Ag District, the parcel where the settlement rock is and the boat launch and asked if they wanted them to be removed. Discussed how they got in the County Ag District and agreed that they were carved out of farmland that was in the County Ag District already. A motion was made by Councilman Volk, seconded by Councilman Chupa to remove these parcels from the County Ag District.
- Clerk Bennett reported to the Board that she had collected \$108,869.11 in taxes, \$2,177.36 in penalty and \$190.00 for second notice fee for a total of \$111,236.47 for the month of March.
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard 26 Vehicle & Traffic, 4 Penal Law, 4 Town Law, 2 Small Claims, 10 ECL and collected \$3,668.50.
- DCO: DCO Hagner issued one ticket, there were seven unlicensed dogs, and two lost dogs that were returned to their owner.
- ATTORNEY: Attorney James Musacchio had nothing to report.
- SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith reported to the Board about the tax freeze and the rebate attached to it and also passed out information on it. He stated that the Town can only raise the budget by \$2726.22 and we have to submit a plan on how we are going to do that for 2016-2019 by June 1. I the school, County, Town and Village stays under the cap the taxpayers may get a check for \$5.00 or less.
- Supervisor Smith also handed out information about the reevaluation.
- BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Volk, seconded by Councilman

Clabeaux to pay General Funds claims #66-81, in the amount of \$6,374.05 as set forth in Abstract #4, dated April 3, 2015, Highway Fund claims #35-45, in the amount of \$3,612.30 as set forth in Abstract #4, dated April 8, 2015. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.

The Supervisor, Town Clerk and Tax Collector's reports for March, 2015 were received by the Board.
