

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DAYTON
WEDNESDAY, JULY 8, 2015
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Diana Clabeaux, Thomas Chupa, Edward Lulas, Ken Volk, Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk, Brian Taber, Highway Superintendent, James Musacchio, Attorney
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they cleaned ditches and did some road resurfacing, did some FEMA work on Hooker Hill, chipped and resealed, also received \$88,544.39 from FEMA.
- Brian got a piggyback bid price from the City of Buffalo on a Freightliner 108SD truck cab with Viking Cives dump body & equipment single axel, larger motor, longer wheelbase and box for \$149,580.60. The Board discussed the purchase and a motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to purchase the truck for \$149,580.60 providing if the truck is delivered before January 1, 2016 the first payment of \$50,000 will be made on delivery and the rest of the cost will be paid by February 15, 2016 and piggybacked on the City of Buffalo bid award Contract #7669. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- DCO: DCO Hagner gave 3 no license notices, responded to one zoning call about goats in a residential area not an Ag & Mkts. call gave to CEO Brecker, picked up one stray and one lost dog, issued seven tickets.
- CLERK: nothing to report
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard 27 Vehicle & Traffic, 2 Town Law, 2 ECL, collected \$2,643.00.
- SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith discussed the a letter to Thomas Ricker, Esq. attorney for Cattaraugus County Bank regarding the reduction in assessment, in which Roxanne Aucoin, Assessor says she cannot lower the assessment because she hasn't got paperwork from the Court, however, the Board of Assessment Review lowered the assessment, Attorney Musacchio told her she had to lower the assessment and she didn't listen to him and the Supervisor opined that she doesn't listen to him either.
- Supervisor and Board also discussed designated roads for snowmobiles and ATV's.
- Supervisor and Board discussed a shared services agreement with Erie County, they all agreed that it would be good to do, so the Supervisor signed the agreement.
- BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Volk, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to pay General Funds claims #108-124, in the amount of \$5,598.46 as set forth in Abstract #7, dated July 8,2015, Highway Fund claims #75-88, in the amount of \$28,003.02 as set forth in Abstract #7,

dated July 8, 2015. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.

The Supervisor, Town Clerk and Tax Collector's reports for June, 2015 were received by the Board.
