

REGULAR MEETING  
TOWN OF DAYTON  
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 10, 2015  
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Diana Clabeaux, Thomas Chupa, Edward Lulas, Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk, Brian Taber, Highway Superintendent, James Musacchio, Attorney, Hugh-Daniel Mosher, Hannah Linenfelser, Danielle Bennett, Students, Absent: Ken Volk
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they cleaned ditches and did some road trenching, cleaned up a tree that went down during a storm, graded dirt roads for the first time, changed a 12" driveway pipe, mowed cemeteries and around the Town Hall.
- Would like to hire an 18 year old at \$9.00 per hour for the summer.
- Brian got an approximate price on a Freightliner single axel, larger motor, longer wheelbase and box for \$91,000 can piggyback on the City of Buffalo bid; fully equipped with plow, dump box, lights etc. approximately \$149,00. After discussion, if Brian can tell the Board how much he has left from the reimbursement the Town received we would not have to borrow any money and if ordered and delivered before Jan 1, 2016 the payment would be made in January, 2016.
- The 1996 truck trade-in about \$10,000, suggested it be put on the internet auction. The box is splitting down the rails.
- CLERK: Clerk Bennett told the Board about the Certificate Kathy Hagner received for the class she went to in Batavia.
- Clerk Bennett asked the Board if she could get a credit card machine in the Town Clerk's office to take payments, the customer would pay the fees. A motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to allow the Town Clerk to procure a credit card machine. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard 35 Vehicle & Traffic, 4 Penal Law, 2 Town Law, 2 ECL, collected \$2,881.00.
- SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith discussed the tentative equalization rate is 75% was 77% last year.
- Health insurance rates for next year Brian's will go up 7.3% and Doug's will go down 7.5%
- BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Clabeaux, seconded by Councilman Chupa to pay General Funds claims #101-107, in the amount of \$3,156.11 as set forth in Abstract #6, dated June 10, 2015, Highway Fund claims #69-74, in the amount of \$1,334.97 as set forth in Abstract #6, dated June 10, 2015. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.

BID OPENING: The Board opened the bids for the 1978 Chev van  
James Pryll \$200 no more than \$350  
Kirk Orth \$290.00  
Nathan Smith \$209.00  
James Pryll's bid was disqualified due to the sliding bid the next highest  
was Kirk Orth and Mr. Orth was awarded the bid.

The Supervisor, Town Clerk and Tax Collector's reports for May, 2015 were  
received by the Board.
