

REGULAR MEETING  
TOWN OF DAYTON  
WEDNESDAY, MAY 13, 2015  
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Diana Clabeaux, Thomas Chupa, Edward Lulas, Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk, Brian Taber, Highway Superintendent, Samantha McDonnell, Observer, Absent: Ken Volk
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Clabeaux, seconded by Councilman Chupa. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they plowed two days, washed sanders and plows and began to paint them, replaced oil pan on truck #7, worked in the Hamlet of Dayton sweeping and cleaning up from winter, did some ditching, cleaned up the cemeteries, and replaced a pipe on the end of Cabic Road.
- The Highway Superintendent would like to put the 1978 Chev van up for bid as surplus equipment. We went to the auction and found a 2003 crew cab truck with a back utility for \$4500.
- The Highway Superintendent would like to hire a part-time person. A motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Chupa to hire a part-time person and pay them up to \$10 per hour depending on experience. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- Discussed replacing the 1996 International truck, it will take 6-8 months to get a new truck. We are still waiting on some more money from FEMA. With the winter recovery money and FEMA money that is left after road projects are finished we then may be able to buy a truck without borrowing a lot of money, the price right now is between \$105,000 and \$135,000.
- CLERK: Clerk Bennett read a notice from NYSDOT that they will be removing the flashing lights before the intersection of Routes 322 & 62, and will replace the flashing yellow and red signal with the red facing west on Route 322 and yellow on Route 62.
- Tax Collector Bennett gave the final report for 2015, she sent \$4,909.05 less taxes back to the County this year and collected \$22.00 more in second notice fees this year, also kept the last interest of \$7.67 in the checking account to keep it open.
- Updated the Board on the upcoming 180 year celebration that is being planned for July 11 starting at 11 a.m. in the park in the Village of South Dayton, Towns of Persia and Perrysburg, Village of South Dayton and the South Dayton Hotel are also participating.
- Clerk Bennett read the Municipal Shelter Report and the Dog Control Officer Inspection Report both were rated satisfactory.
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard 14 Vehicle & Traffic, 3 Penal Law, 3 Town Law, 1 Small Claims, 1 ECL, 1 Parks & Recreation Law, 4

NYCCR6 Law, 1 Civil Fee and collected \$1,961.50.

DCO: DCO Hagner issued one ticket, there were seven unlicensed dogs, and two lost dogs that were returned to their owner.

SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith discussed the tax freeze and all the paperwork that the State is requiring, the Town has the bare essentials, highways, no water, sewer, garbage pickup and no place to cut anymore except for the roads. A motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to opt out of the tax cap and freeze. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.

BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to pay General Funds claims #82-100, in the amount of \$5,161.77 as set forth in Abstract #5, dated May 13,2015, Highway Fund claims #46-66, in the amount of \$12,829.86 as set forth in Abstract #5, dated May 13, 2015. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.

The Supervisor, Town Clerk and Tax Collector's reports for April, 2015 were received by the Board.

ADJOURN: A motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded Councilman Clabeaux at 7:35 p.m., the next meeting will be June 10, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.
