

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DAYTON
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2015
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Diana Clabeaux, Thomas Chupa, Edward Lulas, , Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk, Brian Taber, Highway Superintendent, James Musacchio, Attorney, Rebecca Cuthbert, Observer, Danny Weaver, Rose Gagliano, Roxanne Aucoin, Assessor, Absent: Ken Volk;
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Supervisor called for a moment of silence in memory of those lost on September 11, 2001.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they did a lot of blacktop patching, mowed some road sides and will continue mowing in October. We picked up 4,694 feet of lumber from the trees that were cut here and are now storing it in the Village. We took another load of scrap and got \$216.80 for the load, the sides of the building look better. The road chipping is done for the year, we got a lot of help from neighboring Towns, and in return we helped them.
- Brian thanked Tom Chupa for getting out of his truck and flagging when our guys were too busy talking.
- CLERK: The Town received a letter thanking us for the copy of the resolution regarding NY&LERR grant application.
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard 24 Vehicle & Traffic, 8 Town Law, 1 Penal Law, 1 Civil Law collected \$1,921 .00.
- SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith received a letter of retirement from Douglas Milks effective November 17, 2015 at 3 p.m. He has been an employee for 40 years.
- An ad will be put in the paper for hiring a replacement with a CDL-B license, knowledge of heavy equipment, and be able to pass a drug test.
- Supervisor Smith is asking that requests for inclusion in the 2016 budget be to him by October 1, 2015.
- I received a letter from NYS Department of Taxation that the final equalization rate is 75%.
- ASSESSOR: Roxanne Aucoin said she is having an informal meeting on September 14, 2015 at 7 p.m. in regard to the upcoming revaluation, disclosure notices will be going out at the end of January.
- ATTORNEY: Attorney Musacchio told Mr. Weaver and Ms. Gagliano that he has to speak to former Attorney Ron Ploetz and CEO Gary Brecker, according to the paperwork I have received to date Mr. Huffman is abusing the right of way.

BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Clabeaux, seconded by Councilman Chupa to pay General Funds claims #154-168, in the amount of \$8,262.77 as set forth in Abstract #9, dated September 9,2015, Highway Fund claims #109-121, in the amount of \$9,158.35 as set forth in Abstract #9, dated September 9, 2015. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.

The Supervisor, Town Clerk and Tax Collector's reports for August, 2015 were received by the Board.
