

REGULAR MEETING  
TOWN OF DAYTON  
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 13, 2016  
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Thomas Chupa, Dennis Ackley, Edward Lulas, Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk, James Musacchio, Attorney, Brian Taber, Highway Superintendent, Irene Blakely, Michaelene Comerford, Mark Kane, Raymond Troutman, Absent: Diana Clabeaux
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Ackley, seconded by Councilman Lulas. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they plowed and sanded roads three days, serviced the grader to get it ready for the coming months, cut brush, started to do ditching on various roads, the excavator made it a lot better. We did a lot of sweeping to get a head start on getting the sand off the roads, cleaned sidewalks in the Hamlet of Dayton. The Board needs to think about a salt shed, Bentley Road will be closed during the day periodically to replace sluice pipe, ditch both sides of the road and grind it from the bridge to County Road 2.
- I just found out we will be getting \$77,369.65 in CHIPS money this year.
- CLERK: Clerk Bennett reported the tax collection for March paid to the Supervisor \$2,433.77, County \$113,432.69, for a total collection of \$115,866.46.
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard 40 Vehicle & Traffic, 2 Penal Law, 2 ECL, 1 ABC Law, 1 PRL, 1 Small Claim, 8 Town Law, cases collected \$3278.00.
- The Clerk also reported the Southern Tier West Conference in Houghton is May 11, 2016-7:30 am -3:30 pm
- The Clerk read a letter from the Department of Health regarding the Consolidation of the Town of Dayton and the Village of South Dayton into one registration district for vital records. The vital records for the Village have been turned over to the Town.
- The rabies clinic is Saturday, May 7, 2016 from 9 am to noon at the County DPW garage at 8810 Route 242, Little Valley.
- PUBLIC: Irene Blakely and Michaelene Comerford discussed reduction of assessment and refund of overpaid taxes.
- Raymond Troutman discussed the salty water from his well.
- SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith told the he couldn't find anyone who wanted to be on the Board of Assessment Review, however, the Clerk did receive a call from Kevin Duntley who said he was interested in doing it. A motion was made by Councilman Ackley, seconded by Councilman Chupa to appoint Kevin Duntley to the Board of Assessment Review. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.

ATTORNEY: Attorney Musacchio stated that he was going to discuss what had already been discussed regarding what Mrs. Blakley was talking about.

BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Chupa to pay General Funds claims #53-79, in the amount of \$40,466.29 as set forth in Abstract #4, dated April 13, 2016, Highway Fund claims #36-49, in the amount of \$4,941.08 as set forth in Abstract #4, dated April 13, 2016. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.

The Supervisor, Town Clerk and Tax Collector's reports for March, 2016 were received by the Board.
