

REGULAR MEETING

WEDNESDAY, MAY 11, 2016

- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Ackley. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.

- SUPERVISOR: Rite-Aid called about a flu clinic to be held here, the Board wasn't interested in having one. Dennis Ackley will let them know Dayton is not interested.
- ATTORNEY: Attorney Musacchio tried to phone the Assessor about a Cottage Road property, her mail box was full.
- BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to pay General Funds claims #80-94, in the amount of \$3,942.95 as set forth in Abstract #5, dated May 11, 2016, Highway Fund claims #50-57, in the amount of \$2,804.76 as set forth in Abstract #5, dated May 11, 2016. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.
- The Supervisor, Town Clerk and Tax Collector's reports for April, 2016 were received by the Board.
- The Clerk told the Board that the sign had arrived that was purchased with the JCAP Grant through the Court, it is a double sided sign.
