

REGULAR MEETING  
TOWN OF DAYTON  
WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2017

CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

LOCAL LAW #1: A motion was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to adopt Local Law #1 – Imposing a Six Month Moratorium on the Siting of Commerical Solar Power Projects. A roll call vote was taken on the motion, Clabeaux-aye, Smith-aye, Chupa-aye, Ackley-aye.

MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes as corrected was made by Councilman Clabeaux, seconded by Councilman Chupa. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.

HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they plowed and sanded thirteen days, during the warm days the water level was up from melting snow and rain, however, we had no damage. We did some brush cutting, hauled 35 ton of millings to one of the dirt roads, patched a few pot holes.

RETIREMENT: Received a letter from James Mayers of his intention to retire on April 28, 2017. Brian Taber would like to put an ad in the Observer, PennySaver and also the Town website advertising for applicants for an highway employee.

COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard in January 5 Vehicle & Traffic, 2 Town Law, 5 Penal Law, 2 Small Claim case a total of 24 cases and collected \$582.00.

CLERK: Clerk Bennett reported that we also need to replace two members of the Board of Assessment Review which meets once a year.

BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Ackley to pay General Funds claims #17-31 in the amount of \$16,004.50 as set forth in Abstract #2, dated February 8, 2017, Highway Fund claims #7-17, in the amount of \$16,795.75 as set forth in Abstract #2, dated February 8, 2017. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.

SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith and the Board discussed the Purchasing Policy and decided that they did not need to make any changes.

Supervisor Smith stated that because Councilman Lulas was not present tonight, the traffic control issues in Dayton is tabled. According to the Code Book Chapter 173-Article II-173-4 "Parking on all highways in the Town of Dayton outside the Village of South Dayton is prohibited between the hours of 12 a.m. and 7 a.m. from November 1 of each year to April 15 of the following year."

We have two open places on the Board of Assessment Review-Thomas Chupa said he would serve on one. A motion was made by Councilman Ackley, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to appoint Thomas Chupa to the Board of Assessment Review. A roll call vote was taken on the appointment-Clabeaux-aye, Smith-aye, Chupa-abstain, Ackley-aye.

The Supervisor told the public that are present, if they needed to talk to the

Assessor about their assessment, she is in her office and will stay until she has talked to you.

PUBLIC: Jennifer Dye thanked the Town Board for helping to fix her problem—you really need to consider lowering her pay or getting rid of her.

The Supervisor, and Town Clerk's reports for January, 2017 were received by the Board.

ADJOURN: A motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux, at 7:26 p.m., Carried. The next meeting will be March 15, 2017 at 7 p.m.
