CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Mardino-Miller called the hearing to order at 7:00 p.m. to hear pros and cons on the proposed Local Law #2-Granting partial exemption on Real Property taxation to certain Senior Citizens.

Clerk Bennett read the notice of the hearing that was published in the Observer on September 6, 2019.

Dan Martonis explained that this Local Law would offset any medical expenses that are paid out of pocket not by insurance of senior citizens who might be on the border line of the aged exemption who are now not eligible for it because they may be a couple of dollars over the limit for the exemption. This would include drug expenses, copays etc. that are not paid for by insurance.

Supervisor Mardino-Miller asked if there were any questions, hearing none asked for a motion to close the public hearing.

A motion was made by Councilman Drajem, seconded by Councilman Chupa to close the hearing at 7:03 p.m. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
